






Are you currently or have you ever experienced homelessness?



Do you currently have or have you ever had an Individualized Education Plan?




Are you currently or have you ever been in foster care?





Increased Social-Emotional Skills

- Based on survey responses, YOR is having a positive impact on social-emotional skills of students and results demonstrate relatively consistent findings from the previous year(80-94%)
- Listening to other people, staying out of trouble, caring more about/feeling more comfortable with people of other cultures, races or ethnic groups witnessed increases of 3-4%

Increased Resiliency

• Solid trends from the previous two years (89-92%) 92% of students agree coming to YOR has helped them feel better about themselves and 90% agree that they feel better about their futures

Increased Academic Success and Achievement

• Consistent findings (84-92%) from the previous year with an increase (4%) in students doing better in school and a decrease in student's interest in school (4%)

Increased Post-Secondary and Career Readiness

 Most significant decrease of any area but positive responses remain high (78-91%) 8% decrease in students having a better understanding of how to build and/or sustain a career in the creative industries 6% decrease in students indicating that they feel strongly that youth like me can be artists

Increased Economic Stability

Steady increase across all areas (90-91%) Over 90% of all respondents agree that they are more aware of what education is necessary for different career paths, more aware of what careers might interest them and more confident in their ability to find a job.
